



First Letter of Child's Name Book

Instructions: We are working on letter recognition and alliteration (beginning sounds). We would like for you to have your child create their own book with words and pictures that start with the first letter of their name to share with the class. Please use the construction paper books provided. On the cover of the book, have your child write the first letter of their first name. For example, if the child's name was "Dylan" ...he would write a big letter "D" on the cover of his book. Then, have your child cut out pictures from magazines, print outs from the internet, or newspapers that represent the letter of their first name. For example, he might cut out pictures of a dog, dolphin, duck, dinosaur, and a deer, and then glue/tape one picture on each page of his book. You might even have your child practice writing the words for each picture. Once your child has created their book, go through it with them and point out how each word begins with the same letter. Could they come up with other words that begin with the same letter/sound? Please return this form and their new letter book so we can share it with the class.
