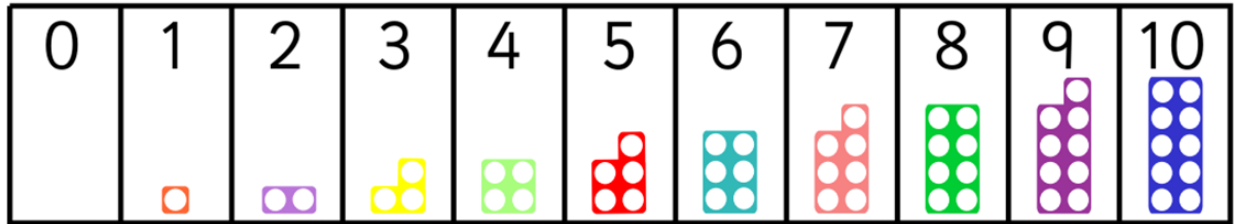


Counting Bags



This math activity is to help your child count and learn the amounts of each number from 1-10. At home have your child count objects and fill the number bag (attached) with that amount. Once the bag is filled with the number amount you are working on then have your child move the slider on the bag to that number. Please assist your child with this activity and help correct if for example, 4 objects are in the bag and they move the slider to 10. Some suggested objects to count are cereal, cars, little toys, bouncy balls, etc.... During the activity ask your child the math questions below:
